Update from Daryl Beltz, June 28th:

Hi Friends,

I would like to say thanks for all of your prayers and concern on our behalf.

This will be just a short update, not much new to report.

I am still going twice a week for transfusions and other doctor appointments ;that is going well.

We met with my oncologist last Friday, she is pleased that my blood work remains fairly stable. In addition I recently finished my first round of chemotherapy. I did well with that, and only had a few side effects. I will begin my second round of chemo next Tuesday. Tentatively I can expect to receive my transplant near the end of August or the beginning of September. My energy level these days is down to zero. I am still having significant pain with my headaches, and the doctor suspects that I am experiencing more bleeding in my head. They have scheduled another CT scan this week on Friday.
