#### 100 Years as The Community Church of Ludington

- In 1923, the official boards of the Congregational and the Presbyterian Churches came together and agreed to a year of cooperation. This experiment was for one year only, ending in October 1924.
- In January 1924, the Rev. H. Irving Parrott was called from Illinois to pastor and take on the task of uniting the two churches.
- Services during the experimental time of cooperation alternated between the two church buildings, with one month at the Presbyterian Church, then one month at the Congregational Church.
