100 Year Anniversary of Community Church

In April 1925, the Community Church corresponded
with the Muskegon Association of Congregational
Churches and the Grand Rapids Presbytery to inform
each of the dissolving of the respective
Congregational and Presbyterian churches to form
The Community Church of Ludington.

The Muskegon Association unanimously passed the
release and prayed for God's blessing and guidance
for the church's future labors.

The Grand Rapids Presbytery Session granted the
request, and invited Rev. Irving J. Parrott to continue
his relations as a corresponding member. The
Presbytery offered support, and continued to support,
our church throughout the years with pastor and
congregation negotiations.
