100 Year Anniversary of Community Church

Jan. 1924 – The Rev. H. Irving Parrott called, takes on the task of uniting the Congregational and Presbyterian churches.

Dec. 1924 – About 350 congregants accepted as charter members of The Community Church of Ludington after signing of documents to join the two churches.

April 1926 – Rev. Parrott died from influenza and pneumonia.

1926 – Rev. F.W. Heldstab accepts call as pastor. An ambitious building program is envisioned during 1928 but could not be realized.

Oct. 1931 – Rev. Paul Haskell Clark became pastor and the church grew during his time as pastor.

Sept. 7, 1947 – The Stearns Memorial Organ was dedicated, sanctuary was also being redecorated.

July 1954 – Rev. A. Allison Amstutz called as pastor. Rev. Amstutz created the carvings in our building.

1956 – Al Juterbock, ordained in 1959, hired to assist Rev. Al Amstutz in youth work.

Nov. 22, 1959 – Dedication services held for the Church School building (north addition).

March 1967 – Rev. Amstutz died following a 6 months illness.
