100th Year Anniversary of Community Church

Charter members of the Community Church of Ludington signed the Purpose and Faith statement on December 17, 1924.

There was a total of 342 charter members, formerly members of the Congregational and Presbyterian churches. Reception numbers were assigned, the first signer being #1, Laura A. Holmes. Our longest living charter member was #91, Alien (Marks) Beaune, member for 77 years. Her sister, #90, Vima (Marks) Lovewell, was also a charter member, member for 73 years. Other charter members: #75, Robert Bailey (67 years); #104, Fred C. Schroeder (30 years); and #135, Erving Hansen – who became the church organist (74 years).
