100th Year Anniversary of Community Church

Nov. 2005 – Rev. Dr. Ronald Houk and Rev. Wayne Buskirk, retired local pastors, hired as co-interim pastors.

June 2004 – Mr. Brett Spalding was called to serve the church. Brett was finishing seminary at Western Seminary in Holland and was ordained in May 2009.

Sept. 2009 – Rev. Spalding accepted a call to the Christian Church in Traverse City. Rev. Buskirk served as interim until Sept. 2011.

July 2011 – Rev. Kathy Dain, newly graduated from seminary, was called. She began a number of new programs and revived a second Sunday service. However, concerns with her leadership style culminated with Rev. Dain leaving for a new calling in November 2012.

Dec. 2012 – Rev. John Brown, trained interim pastor, was contracted through the Presbytery. John was member of Community Church during his youth. Rev. John served through 2016.

Jan. 1, 2017 – Rev. Brett Spalding accepted the call "By Faith" to return as pastor. By faith, and with God's grace and mercy, we now mark 100 years as the Community Church of Ludington.
